

Virtual Meeting Funds Application

Given the current environment and challenges regarding travel, the UFGI administration has decided to offer a <u>limited number</u> of awards to support students attending a virtual conference or workshop.

Eligibility

Students in their second year and above who have not yet scheduled their dissertation defense are eligible to apply for these funds. Students can receive up to \$200 to attend a virtual conference or workshop. Students are not required to present or have funding from their mentor to receive these funds.

Submitting your application

Students who are interested in utilizing these funds must send the following application to Dr. Connie Mulligan (cmulligan@ad.ufl.edu) and Dr. Brittany Hollister (b.hollister@ufl.edu).

Notification of selection

Students will be notified by Dr. Hollister if they have been selected to receive the requested funds. Students must go through their mentor's home department for reimbursement of costs related to the virtual conference/workshop.

Reminder – You must go through your mentor's home department for reimbursement of costs related to virtual meetings.
